SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

 The Maidstone & Mid Kent Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubman's Production Car Trial on Sunday 27th September 2020 at Stoneacre Farm, Otham Kent. The event will be open to all fully elected members of the organizing club, Weald MC, Farnborough & District MC, Anglia Motor Sports Club, and all registered contenders of the 2020 ASEMC Trials Championships. Members of up to the first 12 other Motorsport UK recognised clubs received may also enter and such entry will be deemed acceptance of an invitation on behalf of that club.

The meeting will be held under the Motorsports UK General Regulations (GR) incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the Clubs may issue for the Event.

- 2. The Motorsport UK Clubman's Permit No 118767
- 3. The event will take place at map reference 188 / 800536 and will take place entirely on Private Land. Weather and other circumstances permitting there will be 6 hills, with two runs at each in the morning and two in the afternoon. The Event will start at 10.00 hours. Any competitor who has not checked in with the Secretary of the Meeting by 10.00 hours may be excluded. Competitors may elect to run without a passenger but must declare this on their entry form and continue without throughout the competition. If a competitor elects to carry a passenger, the passenger(s) must hold a R S Clubmans Licence and have completed the pre-event signing on declaration on the Club website. They must also comply with Section 5 below.
- 4. All competitors and passengers must be in possession of a valid **Club Membership Card and a R S Clubman Competition Licence as a minimum.** (T3.1.5)
- 5. Due to Covid-19 management, the following will apply : No passengers shall be carried unless driver and passenger are from the same household or "bubble", in accordance with Government advice.

If a car is to be double driven, both drivers must be individuals meeting with Motorsport UK guidelines as at 27th September 2020.

If the drivers are not from the same house hold :

- No rotation of occupants without sanitizing of vehicle,
- A record of personnel sharing vehicles to be kept.
- Every vehicle to carry hand sanitizer, 60% alcohol content for use by the occupants, noting the flammable nature of the sanitizer and that hands must be fully dried before coming into contact with sources of ignition, such as smoking. Or wipes with a minimum 60% alcohol content are acceptable in lieu of sanitizer.
- 6. Competitors **ALL DRIVERS**: Bring your own hand cleaning gel/wipes as needed. Any driver involved in an incident must indicate that they are OK by signalling with a "thumbs up" at the front windscreen at the earliest opportunity to the approaching marshal. If competitors can safely exit the vehicle, they should do so, then stand in a suitable location and respect social distancing.

Social distancing to be respected at the venue and whilst walking the hills.

Also note that you must agree to the following declaration as part of your entry: Please read and complete the declaration which will be available on the Club Website at www.mmkmc.co.uk a few days before the event. (a link will be emailed to all competitors)

I am not currently experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 and have not been in contact with anyone showing symptoms within the last 14 days, except as a healthcare professional. If after submitting this form I do come into contact (except as a healthcare professional) with someone with COVID-19 or if I start to exhibit any of the signs indicating that I may be infected I will immediately withdraw from the Event, notify Motorsport UK and ensure that my close contacts also do not attend. Should I become ill at or start to exhibit COVID-19 symptoms at the Event I shall withdraw safely and notify the Secretary of the Meeting by telephone / SMS accordingly including identification of those others who I have come into contact with at the Event.

- 7. This an Allday event and no food will be available on site. Food and/or Petrol is available at the M20 Jnt 8 Services, Yeoman Tesco Local on the A20, Lidl on the A274 and Morrison's next to the Kent Police HQ on the A274 all within 2 miles of the venue, should you require them.
- 8. All cars will comply with the 2020 Motorsport UK Vehicle and Tyre Regulations for Car Trials, section T.

The following classes will apply:

- 1. Standard Production Cars. Two Wheel Drive Production Cars, Taxed and MOTed for road use, carrying no ballast, limited modifications. Full interior trim to be retained. Cars in this class can however be trailered to the venue. The original carburettors or fuel injection system including the throttle body and plenum chamber, including the air filter system must be retained. It is permitted to replace the air filter element within the original housing and the exhaust system. It is permitted to fit a sump guard weighing no more than 10kg. Wheels and tyres may be altered in accordance with Motorsport UK GR T11.12 and 11.12.5.
- 2. Front Wheel Drive Production Cars not eligible for Class 1.
- 3. Rear Wheel Drive Production Cars not eligible for Class 1.
- 4. Modified Production Cars and Kit Cars.
- 9. Entrants will need to submit an online pre event vehicle scrutineering declaration. Classification of any vehicle will be entirely at the discretion of the organisers. Visual spot checks may be undertaken.
- 10. No awards will be presented for this event.
- 11. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and closes at 10.00am on **Monday 21st September 2020.**
- . Entries will only be accepted on line via the Club Website at <u>www.mmkmc.co.uk</u> and be accompanied by the appropriate fee. The entry fee is **£35.00**. Payment may be made by BACS to MMKMC Bank Account sort code 60-60-08 Account No 00045349, PayPal or by post to the Secretary of the meeting. Please state your name and event name if paying by BACS Entry fees may be refunded at the organizer's discretion.

- 13. The maximum number of entries for this event is 40 the minimum is 15. There is no maximum or minimum class entry. Should the minimum entry figure not be reached, the organizer's reserve the right to cancel the meeting. A maximum of two (at the organizer's discretion) drivers per car will be accepted, each being treated as a separate entry. Final instructions will be made available to entrants before the start of the competition. The signing on form (a link will be emailed to all competitors) will include the necessary pre-event declaration required by MOTORSPORT UK. A separate pre-event declaration form must be completed prior to the event by passengers.
- 14. We bring your attention GR T4.1 4.1.11 and remind you that no front passenger may be under the age of 12 years and that the Passenger(s) comprising the crew at the start must not be altered during the competition.
- 15. Starting order will be in accordance with GR T5.2.
- 16. Penalties will be as GR T7.5 as printed.
- Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event and will be available on the Club Website <u>www.mmkmc.co.uk</u>. Protests must be made in accordance with GR C5.
- 18. Identification numbers will be allocated by the organisers but the supply of this is the responsibility of the entrants and must be fixed in a prominent forward-facing position.
- 19. All marshals are appointed "Judges of Fact" to adjudicate on items listed under GR T7.1 5.
- 20. As the event takes place on private property, apart from Class 1, cars need not be currently registered, taxed and MOT'ed, but they must be properly silenced.
- 21. In accordance with latest General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) the information you give us will be used only for the purpose of running MMKMC events and its activities. You will only receive communications from us that are relevant to the events you enter. Photographs may be taken at this event (and others in the programme) and shared, including on social media. Please advise the organiser if you do not wish to have your photograph taken.
